 - Flexibility with student summer schedules
 - Weekly meetings, updates and feedback

Requirements:

- Applicant must be enrolled or plan to enroll in an MSI Summer 2018 course.
- Applicant must be available to intern ~20 hours per week during fellowship.
- Applicant must be independent and self-sufficient.

- Applicant should have an interest in sustainability.

- MSI Block B: June 4-June 16, 2018
- Fellowship Dates: June 4-August 9, 2018 (flexible)
- MSI Fellowship Ceremony: August 10, 2018 (tentative)
